Study load

- ▶ The number of contact hours per week in the first year of the programme is 20 hours. Contact hours include: 50-minute teaching hours, tutorials, overseeing projects and any other online/offline contact between the lecturer and the student.
- ▶ Approx. 20 hours per week are dedicated to projects, research, assignments and self-study.
- ▶ Each academic year, you can earn 60 credits. If you have earned less than 50 credits at the end of the first year of enrolment, AUAS will issue you a negative binding study advice (BSA). This means you will not be able to continue the programme.

Enrolment and study check

Enrol no later than 1 May via studielink.nl/en. Living in the Netherlands? Please use your DigiD to apply. Residing outside the Netherlands? Apply for a username and password on studielink.nl/en. Applicants with a Dutch secondary school diploma are to complete the mandatory study check. Applicants with a non-Dutch diploma are exempt.

Admission requirements

- ▶ Dutch diplomas: all profiles from VWO; HAVO with a minimum avg. grade of 8; both with the addition of one of the 5 subjects: Mathematics A or B or Economics or M&O or Business Economics are accepted.
- ▶ International diplomas: we require evidence that you have passed the standardised examinations for university entrance of your country of origin. More information: www.nuffic.nl/en/diploma-recognition.
- ▶ All applicants are expected to have good written and verbal skills in English.
