

- 1. First selection will be made by the end of March. The remaining places will be open to students enrolling between 11 and 15 April
- 2. Students must be there from the very beginning to the very end of the semester
- 3. The semester programme has to be taken as a whole as it is a coherent package
- 4. Programming skills are required for all semesters
- 5. You need to upload your CV and transcript in our enrollment system Students come and go in order for us to check if your background matches your choice
- 6. AFTER acceptance, we will change your application from pending to enrolled in our system. If you cannot be accepted, you will be informed as well
- 7. Students must be prepared to do team work during the whole semester
- 8. Students in the Mobile Development semester will do a project in a company for two days a week. Travel costs might be incurred and have to be paid by the students themselves
- 9. The following electives are offered to exchange students in order to earn 30 ECTS:
 - Survival Dutch (2 ECTS)
 - o Intercultural Skills (2 ECTS)
 - English: Communicating like a pro (2 ECTS)
