Health insurance	<p>Dutch law requires everyone living in the Netherlands to have health insurance. Students must make sure that they have adequate coverage (i.e. health care costs and personal and professional liability). If the insurance you have in your own country provides full cover for medical costs and legal liability while you are in the Netherlands, you should bring with you a statement in English detailing the insurance cover.
